This means that internal examiners at HA, HD and CM using Censor IT should now start filling in the examiner's reports that you receive through the Censor IT system for your exams this summer. This applies to both written and oral exams.

NEW SYSTEM TO PREVENT COMPUTER VIRUS



An increasing number of threats from a new type of computer virus that traditional antivirus software is not able to counter has been detected at AU, and IT Support is therefore deploying a new system to help us.

The new system is based on a central database that contains information about programmes and files that definitely contain this new type of computer virus, and the system will prevent you from accidentally running any of these malicious programmes or files.

However, there are other programmes and files which may contain the new type of virus, and you may therefore experience that the system will ask you to confirm when running a new programme or opening a new files. If you are in doubt whether it is safe to run a programme or open a file when the system prompts you, you should contact IT Support: 8715 0933 / <u>bss.it@au.dk</u>.

The new system is called McAfee TIE and will be installed on your computer automatically – you don't have to do anything.
