The VILLUM Foundation calls for applications for the VELUX Visiting Professor Programme 2012-2014.

The object of the programme is to strengthen research and education in Denmark by supplementing Danish research environments with international experience and knowledge, and promoting the development of international research networks and teaching programmes.

Each visiting professor is expected to engage actively in research and teaching at the host institution, incl. supervision of students writing dissertations and PhD theses, delivering lectures, holding seminars and workshops, etc. A visiting professorship may last for a minimum of 2 months and a maximum of 6 months.

Economists until the age of 35 (born 1977 or later) are invited to apply for the Kiel Institute's Excellence Award in Global Economic Affairs 2013 by submitting up to three published or unpublished papers in the field of global economic affairs, and specifically pertaining to the following areas:

- International Trade and FDI
- Knowledge Creation and Growth

- Poverty Reduction, Equity and Development
- Environmental Policy
- Reforming the Welfare Society
- Labour Market Policy
- Monetary Policy
- Financial Markets and Macroeconomic Activity

Submitted papers will be evaluated by a jury. The top contestants will be granted the "Excellence Award in Global Economic Affairs" at a prize-giving ceremony at the Kiel Institute. In addition, they will receive a Research Fellowship at the Kiel Institute, entitling them to a research visit to the Institute, all expenses paid. Research Fellows will receive research support, access to the Institute's Virtual Research Communities and the opportunity to participate in the Institute's research projects and events.
