

### GRANT FROM THE CARLSBERG FOUNDATION TO JONAS MAIBOM



Research Assistant <u>Jonas Maibom</u> has received DKK 1.4 million from the <u>Carlsberg Foundation</u> for his postdoc project.

The aim of the project is to combine empirical and structural labour supply models to answer important policy questions. The first project will quantify and assess how the current level of UI balances the gain from social insurance with costs generated by suboptimal individual behavior. The second project will quantify the central mechanisms behind career and wage effects associated with mothers spending time out of the labour market and assess the cost of family friendly policies in terms of fore-gone opportunities in the labour market for mothers.
