NEW WASTE BINS FOR PAPER



In the beginning of December, the waste bin in your office will be replaced by an A4 paper tray which must be used for waste paper. The paper tray can be placed in your bookcase and can be used with or without its top section – there will be instructions on it.

If you want to dispose of the waste paper yourself in the nearest copy room, you should attach the sticker, which will be handed out, to your tray. If you do not want to handle the waste paper yourself, you do not have to do anything – the cleaning staff will continue to handle your waste paper as usual.

The procedure for handling residual waste has not changed; that is, you should still put residual waste in the small white plastic bags and place them in the kitchen bins.

Along with your new paper tray, you will receive instructions explaining, among other things, what waste paper is (clean paper), and what goes under the definition of residual waste (candy wrappers, napkins, used paper plates, food etc.).

This new procedure is part of a pilot project at Campus Fuglesangs Allé with the aim of making it easier for you to sort your waste and to make the work easier for the cleaning assistants. The project will be evaluated in the spring of 2016 to see if the procedure should continue and be implemented at other parts of Aarhus BSS.
