### Press clippings in PURE

ASB Library, Business and Social Sciences, has for some time worked on importing press clippings about researchers at the former ASB into PURE. The project started as a beta-version on 1 January 2012. Press clippings are brief and clear summaries from selected media containing links to the full text article. Infomedia, who monitors a vast number of media, delivers the press clippings, which are selected according to defined selection criteria. A PURE-editor at the ASB Library approves the press clippings, and they are then imported into PURE and linked to the relevant researcher's homepage. Press clippings which are not automatically delivered by Infomedia can be registered in PURE by the researcher, and unwanted press clippings can be removed. The press clipping project is planned to cover all researchers at Business and Social Sciences, and is planned to run until 1 March 2012. [Read more about the project here.](#)
