TWO RECIPIENTS OF AUFF STARTING GRANTS AT THE DEPARTMENT





Two researchers at the Department have received Starting Grants from Aarhus University Research Foundation (AUFF):

Søren Dalsqaard, NCRR, has received an Associate Professor Starting Grant of DKK 2,900,000 for his project on environmental risk factors for ADHD entitled "Air-pollution and drinking water - a population-based cohort study of environmental risk factors for ADHD". The aim of the project is to estimate whether and to which extent exposure to air-pollution or chemical compounds in drinking water, either during pregnancy or early childhood, is associated with ADHD.

Anders Bredahl Kock, <u>CREATES</u>, has received an Assistant Professor Starting Grant of DKK 1,815,000. The grant will be used to create an interdisciplinary environment within the field of high-dimensional econometrics and statistics. This will be done by hiring a postdoctoral researcher for three years and by organizing a conference on this topic as well as inviting relevant seminar speakers.

THE DEPARTMENT'S MENTORING SCHEME



The Department is committed to providing mentoring to all assistant professors and post-docs. The heads of sections match every junior faculty member to a senior faculty mentor following a bottom-up process wherever possible, i.e. the mentee suggests their own mentor. Currently, all juniors have been matched, and all new assistant professors and post-docs will be matched shortly after they begin their employment contract.

A one-year mentoring process has been initiated starting 1 February 2016, which will be evaluated after 12 months, in January 2017. If mentors and mentees wish to continue meeting after this date, they are welcome to do so. If mentees wish to switch mentors at any time, they should contact <u>Nabanita</u> <u>Datta Gupta</u>.

NEW GUIDELINES FOR CATERING AT MEETINGS WITH EXTERNAL PARTICIPANTS




The guidelines regarding catering at meetings with external participants (e.g. a seminar guest, job candidate etc.) and advisory boards (incl. PhD assessment committees) when funding is provided by the Department have been changed.

In connection with off-site catering (i.e. at a restaurant), the maximum amount may not exceed DKK 450 per person for lunch and DKK 800 per person for dinner, and the number of internal participants per guest may not exceed two persons.

If lunch is taking place at the Department's premises, the maximum number of internal participants is three persons per external guest.

CHANGED RATES IN CONNECTION WITH OFFICIAL TRAVEL



If you are planning to travel, please be aware that the amount of allowances for additional expenses on business trips in Denmark and abroad was changed as of 1 January 2016.

The changes apply to rates for:

- transport allowance expenses in connection with travel by private car or similar means of transport.
- hotel allowance
- hourly and daily allowances expenses for meals, daily necessities, transportation at the final destination and so on.
- percentage allowance expenses for meals, daily necessities, transportation at the final destination and so on.

• undocumented night work allowance - 'Thank you for your trouble' in connection with private accommodation.

FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES



The following funding opportunities may be relevant to you:

FACE: Fund for Academic Cooperation and Exchange between Denmark and the Arab World

Established as a new Danish-Arab Partnership Programme (DAPP) engagement to support academic cooperation between Denmark and the MENA region.

Danish institutions that have entered into collaboration with partners from the MENA region can apply for funding for academic partnership projects.

FACE supports two types of grants:

- Large grants (between DKK 50,000 and 2,000,000 per year). Deadline is 30 March 2016.
- Small grants (up to DKK 50,000 DKKK) for e.g. academic exchange visits, organizing of conferences, seminars and meetings, etc. Deadline is 1 March 2017.

NORFACE: Dynamics of Inequality Across the Lifecourse: structures and processes (DIAL)

New Opportunities for Research Funding Agency Co-operation in Europe (NORFACE) is a collaborative partnership of national research funding agencies from 18 European countries in the area of social and behavioral sciences.

The DIAL call for proposals has four themes:

- 1. early life influences and outcomes
- early adult transitions into tertiary education, vocational training and economic activity
- 3. labour market and family trajectories and the growth of inequality
- 4. labour market participation in later life and retirement.

The deadline for phase one applications is 30 March 2016.

A project requires minimum 3 partners from the participating countries.

The budget limit is \in 1,500,000 across all participating partners.
