
COVID-19 guidelines

- when using the lecture room

AVOID

Avoid lingering in corridors, staircases, entrance halls, etc. where it may become crowded.
Avoid leaving the room before the lecture is over.

ENTRANCE

Enter through the usual entrance door - take the available seat farthest from the entrance so that others don't have to push their way past you to find a seat.

EXITS

Exit via the designated exit only - leave the room tidy and let the people closest to the exit leave first.

STUDENTS' RESPONSIBILITY

The last student to leave the row is responsible for disinfecting the entire row.

1. Start by disinfecting your hands
2. Disinfect the tables and chairs (not fabric surfaces) in the row. Remember to disinfect all contact surfaces (table edges, underneath the table, armrests, etc.) Use the disinfectant for all surfaces (spray bottle). Leave the surface moist but not wet.
3. Disinfect the other contact surfaces (hand railings, door handles, sockets, etc.).

To ensure safety and compliance with official rules and guidelines, teaching staff are authorised to cancel teaching activities, if this is considered necessary.

CLEANING

The lecture room has been cleaned before the start of the lecture, but please use hand sanitisers where and whenever these are provided.
