





- The picture above shows what the camera will covering when using preset 2.









Share Screen:


• If you wish to share your screen, press the "Share Screen" button.

• If you wish to stop your screen sharing, press the "Stop Share" as indicated below.




- After doing this, you will return to your own screen.

• Before sharing screen, start the slide show in PowerPoint, this makes it easier to share it with the students








- Alt-TAB and select your current Zoom meeting.
